South Marston-born Alfred Williams (1877-1930) was both a literary and a folksong hero, having written vividly about the local area and collected local folk songs in order to save them for posterity. This unique evening of entertainment and education will feature live performances of songs he collected, and a demonstration of traditional folk music instruments, along with talks and readings from his books. The Folksong Evening is a fundraising event for the recently formed Alfred Williams Heritage Society, which is organising a two-day festival in Swindon on November 12 & 13, dedicated to the life and works of this extraordinary local hero.
